Classes duration are of 45 minutes with 5 minutes to rest.



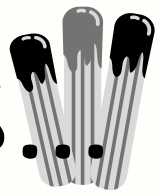
04 MEALTIMES

People typically eat breakfast around 7-8:30 AM, a light lunch at 12-1PM, and dinner early, between 5:30-7 PM.

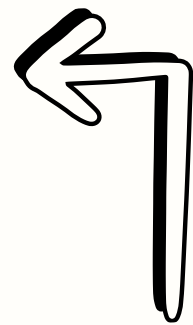
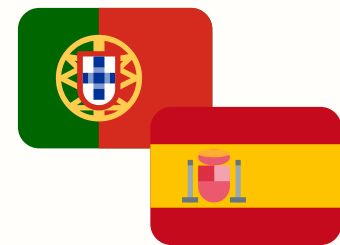

01 CHURROS...

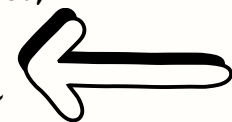

02 CULTURAL HABITS

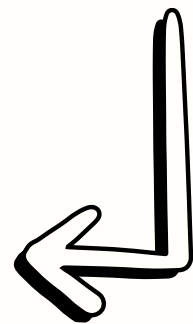

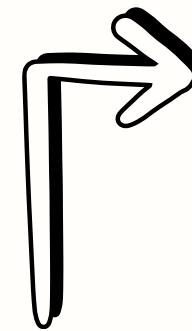
03 WEATHER

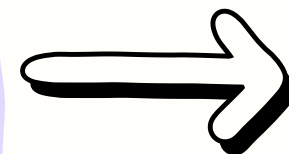
04 HUTSPOT

05 CULTURAL HABITS



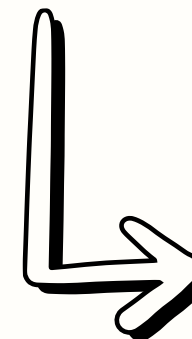
